

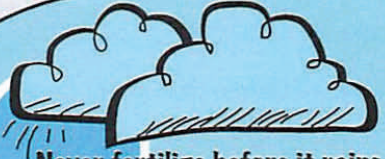

Wash your car at a car wash facility.



Never fertilize before it rains.



Dry sweep, don't hose your driveway.



Careful with chemicals - fertilizers, pesticides, ice melt. Don't over water.



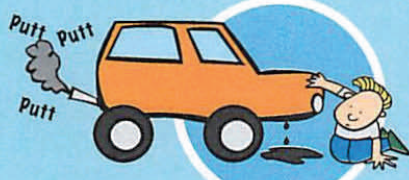
Cover bare soil.



Keep yard waste out of ditches and storm drains.



Paint without pollution. Rinse latex paint brushes in the sink; filter and reuse oil-based paint thinners.



Keep your car leak-free.



Recycle used motor oil. Do not pour down the storm drain.
