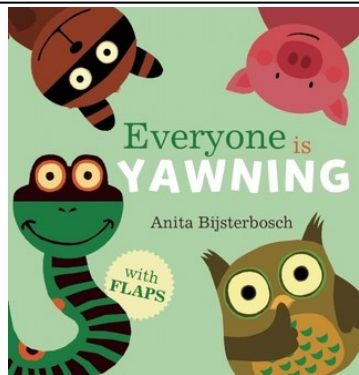
Theme: Bedtime
